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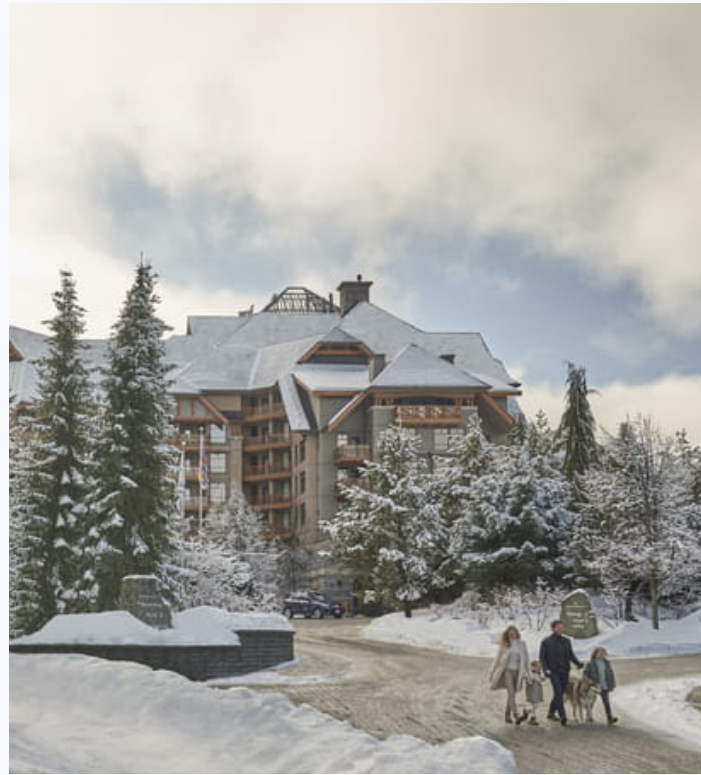


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Reasons to Work at Four Seasons Whistler

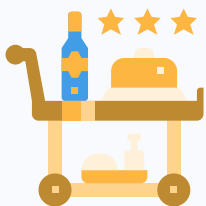

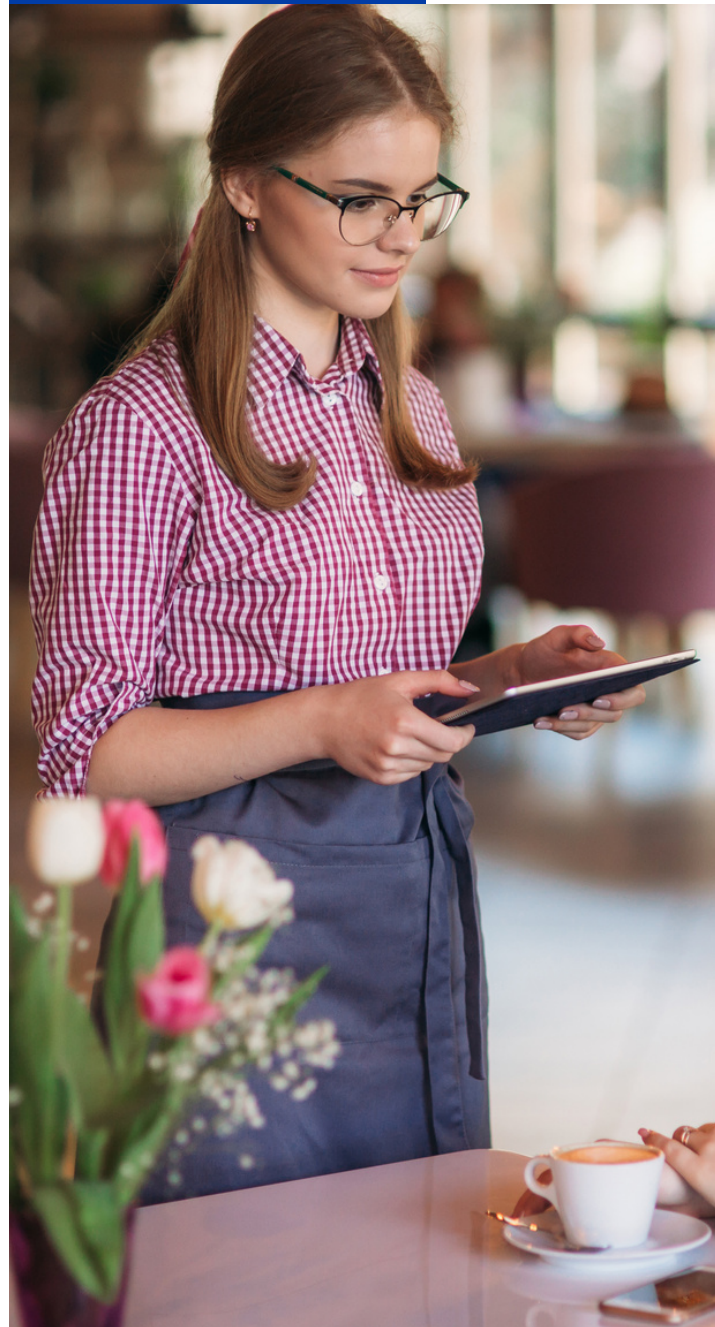

Getting a Job and Accommodation is this easy:

1

Take Tamwood's online English Assessment to see if you have the English level required for admission (don't worry, if you need to improve your English you can sign up for English classes with Tamwood)

2

Apply for one or both of the Tamwood Co-op programs in Whistler and include a CV/resume in English; a cover letter to the hotel HR Manager saying why they should hire you

3

Book a Tamwood English Assessment Interview (<https://tamwoodcareers.simplybook.me/v2/>) and meet with Tamwood to **assess your speaking and listening skills**

4

If you qualify for the program, **Tamwood will send your CV/Resume, Cover Letter to the employer** for consideration

5

Hotel will invite you to **book an interview** using an online calendar if they want to meet you

6

Attend virtual interview with hotel HR staff at time scheduled

7

If interested in you, **the hotel may ask you to do another interview and complete an online job application form**

8

If they want to hire you, the hotel will **forward a job offer for you** to Tamwood. Offer is conditional on you completing your enrolment with Tamwood, **paying for your program**, and **securing the necessary study and work permits**

9

Sign Job offer and return

10

Apply for Visa

11

Pay Tamwood

12

Secure Visa, book travel, arrive in Canada, get SIN in Vancouver and then transfer to Whistler

13

Move into staff housing

14

Start classes at Tamwood and part-time work at the hotel
