Themed campus tour which encourages campers to develop teambuilding, leadership or STEAM skills.

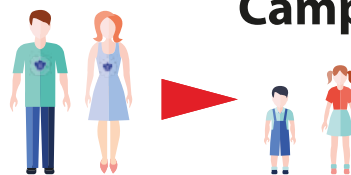
CAMPER WELCOME NIGHT:
