This Vancouver Island Adventure begins with a 90-minute ferry ride through the beautiful Gulf Islands. Upon arrival, enjoy a scenic bus ride to Beach Hill Park where you will be surrounded by natural beauty while enjoying a picnic lunch in the great outdoors. This afternoon, you will embark on sightseeing opportunities at the world-famous Empress Hotel, British import shops, the Royal BC Museum, the Royal London Wax Museum, Parliament buildings or other attractions in Victoria's Inner Harbour. For a little more adventure, participate in an optional Whale Watching tour (extra cost option) before heading back to Vancouver.

This sea-to-sky adventure makes its first stop at Shannon Falls, BC's 3rd largest waterfall (reaching 1,105 feet / 335 meters), for a photo opportunity and short stretch. From here, enjoy the vistas of the Tantalus Mountain Range as you proceed along the highway to the world renowned Whistler Resort – where you can create your own adventure! Whistler offers something for everyone, whether it's a short walk around Lost Lake, a more adventuresome hike at 6,000 feet above sea level (the top of Whistler Mountain), a scheduled activity such as horseback riding, or simply a walk through the picturesque village and a picnic lunch at a near by park, you are sure to enjoy this trip.

Grouse Mountain/Robson St.
