SFU facilities used by Tamwood Summer Camps

Residences

Mc Taggart Cowan Residences

Both single and double rooms



Boys and girls are on separate floors. Staff members sleep on the same floor as their students to ensure 24-hour supervision. The Director and senior staff have their offices on the third floor of McTaggart Cowan so that they are easily accessible.

Dining Facility

Raven's Cafeteria

Offers the best view on campus as well as outdoor seating.



Every student is provided with three nutritious meals and an evening snack every day. Campers have their buffet style meals on the upper level of Raven's cafeteria. Teens eat on the main level and use piper cards to choose what they would like. They are able to choose from a variety of entrée's, salads, sandwiches, pizza, etc.



Computer Labs/ Classrooms

SFU has excellent computing systems and classroom facilities.



All Tamwood SFU students attend English class for 15 hours a week and have access to computers with free email so that they can communicate with family and friends back home.

Athletic Fields

A 400-meter, six lane, rub-a-turf running track surrounds the sports field. There are also three additional fields located behind the residence, which are very popular for soccer, football, and rugby



Campers do a variety of activities each week and on at least one day of the week they participate in an athletic activity such as soccer, ultimate frisbee, volleyball, etc. Teens who sign up for the athletic activity also use the same facilities for similar sports but at a different time

Aquatic Center

The SFU Aquatic Center houses a 6 lane competitive pool and a dive tank with towers and springboards.



Through out camp both Campers ages 7-12 are able to enjoy SFU's indoor pool as a scheduled evening program. Teen campers swim at outdoor pools in Vancouver on their half day excursions.



Gymnasium

SFU's two gyms can be configured for badminton, volleyball, basketball, indoor soccer, and general use activities.



Tamwood students are able to play a variety of games such as basketball, volleyball and floor hockey as a part of the athletic program.

Kayaking Facility

Barnet Marine Park is located on the spectacular Burrard Inlet. The park is a fantastic location for Tamwood's kayaking program. Picnic tables are scattered under shady trees and a concession stand, change rooms and outdoor showers are available in summer.



Kayaking is one of Tamwood's most popular activities. Students in the camper program will have the opportunity to kayak once a week; those in the Teen program are given the choice to kayak once a week.
