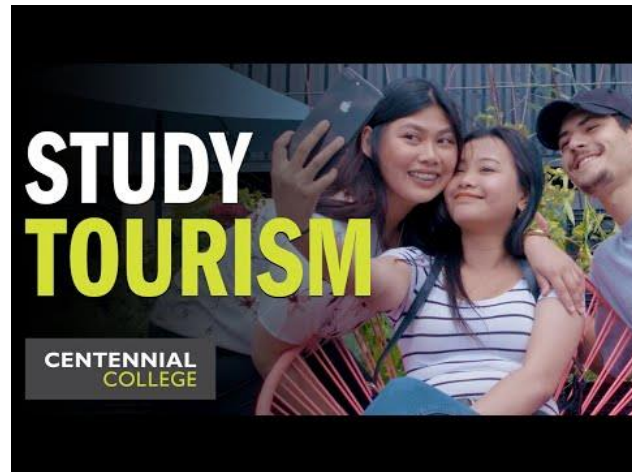

Required English level completion:

- Academic IELTS 6.5 (minimum 6.0 in each band)
- TOEFL IBT 88 (no sub-score less than 22)

Conditional admissions:

Not available. Students should meet all admission requirements to apply. Tamwood students can apply when they are enrolled on Pathway program, but they will need to take an English test at the end of EAP 194 level.

Fees:

Non-refundable application fee: 95 CAD

Deposit: first semester fees about 7000 CAD.

Approximate annual tuition fees: 15000-20000 CAD

Application process:

1. Book Tamwood Pathway Program.
2. Apply using PDF application form together with all scanned documents and send it to Regional Admissions Team member. Use "GSPC Management" as the agency.
Wait about 4-6 weeks.
3. Receive the letter of offer and pay the deposit.
4. Receive the Letter of Acceptance in about 3 days and apply for a Study Permit.

Application deadlines:

Rolling intake. Recommend to apply at least 3 months in advance.
