is your first step to achieving your dreams of earning a qualification from a college or university in Canada. Students who take the pathway program get consistent support and counselling to ensure a seamless transfer into their chosen reputable partner college or university.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is suitable for students whose first language is not English and whose goals are to pursue undergraduate or post-graduate study, technological or career and vocational programs. **The language requirement can be waived at a partner college or university with successful completion of this course.**

The Pathway program includes different levels of English for Academic Purposes classes:

EAP 192

- Entry Requirement: Tamwood English Assessment Test into EAP 192, or evidence of any test score equivalent to IELTS 5.0 (subscores in reading and writing must be 5.0, subscores in listening and speaking must be no lower than 4.5).
- This course takes students with Intermediate level from IELTS 5.0 to 5.5 level with a strong focus on building academic and language skills

EAP 193

- Entry Requirement: Tamwood English Assessment Test into EAP 193, completion of EAP 192 with minimum of 70% or evidence of any test score equivalent to IELTS 5.5 (subscores in writing and reading must be 5.5; subscores in listening and speaking must be no lower than 5.0).
- This course takes students with Intermediate level from IELTS 5.5 to 6.0 level with a strong focus on building academic and language **skills**

EAP 194

- Entry Requirement: Tamwood English Assessment Test into EAP 194, completion of EAP 193 with minimum of 70% or evidence of any test score equivalent to IELTS 6.0 (subscores in writing and reading must be 6.0; subscores in listening and speaking must be no lower than 5.5).
- This course takes students with Intermediate level from IELTS 6.0 to 6.5 level with a strong focus on critical thinking academic skills

Minimum age 19 years

Language Skill You must demonstrate you have an intermediate level/level 4 English with Tamwood Careers' online written test and admission interview, or by presenting evidence of having achieved any of the following: CEFR B1, IELTS 5, TOEFL ibT 52 – 64, Cambridge PET (Merit) or Tamwood Language Centres' level 4.

NOTE

These minimum requirements cannot be waived by either the institution or the student.

Toronto Students Only

Evidence that the student has an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent or has passed the Wonderlic Scholastic Level Exam with a Cut Score of 16.
