Application process:

- 1. Book Tamwood Pathway Program.
- 2. Application is online through Tamwood Pathway Department; documents may be uploaded in PDF. Wait about 1 week.
- 3. Receive the Letter of offer and pay the deposit or full fees within 21 day after the letter was issued.
- 4. Receive the Letter of Acceptance in about 1-3 days and apply for a Study Permit.

Application deadlines:

February 1 for all programs, after that deadline - Rolling intake. Recommend to apply at least 3 months in advance.
