Application process:

- 1. Book Tamwood Pathway Program.
- 2. Apply with Tamwood Pathway Department, use Tamwood booking as a proof of English, and pay the non-refundable application fee.

Wait about 3-4 weeks.

- 3. Receive the letter of offer and pay the deposit.
- 4. Receive the Conditional Letter of Acceptance.
- 5. Complete Tamwood pathway program and upload the graduation certificate.
- 6. Receive the Letter of Acceptance and apply for a Study Permit.

May intake: March 1

September intake: August 1

Note: we highly recommend applying as soon as possible, at least 3 months before the start date.
