

Fees:

Non-refundable application fee: 100 CAD.

Deposit: about 9000 CAD – equivalent to first term semester fees.

Approximate annual tuition fees: 18400 CAD.

Application process:

- 1. Book Tamwood Pathway Program.
- 2. Tamwood sends online application and scanned documents to Douglas, using student's e-mail. The student pays the non-refundable application fee. Douglas will not process incomplete application. Wait about 1 week.
- 3. Receive the letter of offer and pay the deposit within 1 month.
- 4. Receive the Conditional Letter of Acceptance in about 3 days.
- 5. Complete Tamwood Pathway program, and graduation documents will be sent to Douglas by Pathway department.
- 6. Receive the Letter of Acceptance in about 3 days and apply for a Study Permit.
