Fees:

- Non-refundable application fee: 100 CAD
- Deposit: 7800 CAD or ~13000 CAD for India, china, Vietnam, Morocco, Pakistan, Senegal and Philippines.
- Approximate annual tuition fees: about 13000 CAD (depends of number of courses per year and program).

Application process:

1. Book Tamwood Pathway Program.
2. Apply here <https://apply.educationplannerbc.ca/> using students' e-mail, use Tamwood booking as a proof of English, and pay the non-refundable application fee. Then submit unofficial documents here international@coastmountaincollege.ca. Official documents should be mailed in sealed envelope directly from the student's institution to CMTN.
Wait about 4-6 weeks.
3. Receive the letter of offer and pay the deposit.
4. Receive the Conditional Letter of Acceptance.
5. Complete Tamwood pathway program and upload the graduation certificate.
6. Receive the Letter of Acceptance and apply for a Study Permit.

Application deadlines:

Admissions:

There are no deadlines, but admission is granted on a first-come, first-serve basis. So please apply as soon as possible, maximum 12 months in advance, minimum 3 months in advanced. There are tentative deadlines for some popular programs.

Winter: 1 July.

Fall: 1 March.
