All programs available for international students. Certificate, Diploma or Bachelor Degree.

Non-refundable application fee: 150 CAD.
Deposit: first semester fees about 2500 CAD.
Approximate annual tuition fees: 19200 CAD.
University Preparation 5 fees for 14 weeks: 5310 CAD.

Application process:

1. Book Tamwood Pathway Program.
2. Apply here <https://international.viu.ca/admissions> using students' email, use Tamwood booking as a proof of English, and pay the non-refundable application fee. "Program Choice" – pick "VIU English Language Certification Program" – "ESL – followed by academic studies" AND "University Program at VIU"
Wait about 2 weeks.
3. Receive the letter of offer and pay the deposit.
4. Receive the Conditional Letter of Acceptance.
5. Complete Tamwood pathway program and upload the graduation certificate.
6. Receive the Letter of Acceptance and apply for a Study Permit.
