

The Tamwood Outdoor Leadership (TOL) program is a Tamwood-designed program, based at Tamwood Vancouver & Whistler Summer Camp, designed to offer integrated learning opportunities for campers aged 13 to 17. The TOL program focuses on place-based education, environmental sustainability, active citizenship and outdoor adventure and challenges.

As part of Tamwood's discovery learning module, students are provided with direct experiences that enable them to integrate their learning into the wider world and to make personal connections with the outdoors.

Adventure and Challenges:

The Tamwood Outdoor Leadership (TOL) program introduces each student to a variety of outdoor activities including:

- Hiking and backpacking
- Kayaking and/or Canoeing
- Rock Climbing and/or Biking
 Essential outdoor skills (minimum) impact camping, outdoor cooking, first aid, navigation, weather interpretation, shelter construction and risk reduction)

Program Structures and Projects:

Over the course of a two-week program, students will be involved in one major projects per week. Throughout the week the students will be divided into groups for one activity and then are remixed into different groups for another activity. The activities include a combination of field studies, overnight trips, enquiry projects and classroom based academics.
