Fees:

Non-refundable application fee: 250 CAD

Deposit: applicants will need to pay their fees in 3 installments: 50% of tuition, then in 4 months 25% of tuition, then in 4 months 25% of tuition.

Approximate annual tuition fees: 13000 - 16000 CAD.

Scholarships: not available. But need to check when apply, as sometimes the college offers some grands/scholarships to international students.

Application process:

- 1. Book Tamwood Pathway Program.
- 2. Complete registration form and send it via e-mail to CU, use Tamwood booking as a proof of English, and pay the non-refundable application fee.
 - Wait about 1 week.
- 3. Receive the letter of offer and pay the deposit.
- 4. Receive the Conditional Letter of Acceptance.
- 5. Complete Tamwood pathway program and upload the graduation certificate.
- 6. Receive the Letter of Acceptance and apply for a Study Permit.

Applications for all full-time programs will be accepted on an ongoing basis. We recommend to apply 3-4 months before the start date.
