PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Discover your potential with the Future of Work program at Tamwood Camps - a unique experience for teens passionate about making a difference in the professional world. Guided by dedicated mentors and inspired by industry experts, participants engage in hands-on projects and develop essential skills in leadership, teamwork and sustainability. You will observe industry experts in action, ask them questions, and draw inspiration for your final project, gaining firsthand insights into real-world careers.

Our Future of Work campers gain confidence and a purpose driven mindset, ready to navigate and succeed in the ever-evolving world of work.

PROGRAM FOCUS

- ★ Participants gain exposure to real-world applications through visits to innovative companies and insights from guest speakers, providing first hand perspectives on careers in sustainability and innovation
- ★ Participants learn the fundamentals of crafting an impactful pitch and presentation, focusing on building a clear story and structure that leaves a lasting impression
- ★ Participants will work together to select one focus area and create a project that aligns with key Sustainable Development Goals. At the end of the two-week program, they will present their final projects to a panel for feedback

PROGRAM PRE-REQUISITES:

What we look for when considering Future of Work program candidates:

- ★ **Age Requirement:** Must be between 15 and 17 years old
- ★ **English Proficiency:** Intermediate English speaking skills to ensure campers can confidently participate in discussions, presentations and activities
- ★ **Public Speaking Skills:** Comfortable standing up and speaking in front of a group
- ★ **Willingness to Collaborate:** Openness to working with peers from diverse cultural backgrounds and actively contributing to group projects
- ★ Capacity to follow policies and rules with a positive and flexible attitude
